

**MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (DDC) MEETING HELD ON 6th May' 2022
AT 11.30 A.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, KARIMGANJ.**

The meeting was presided over by Shri Mridul Yadav, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Karimganj. Initiating the discussion, the Dist. Dev. Commissioner, Karimganj welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Thereafter, review was started on the progress of different departments as well as achievement on action point and monitorable targets of D.C's conference.

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

Then the meeting ended with vote of thanks from the Chair.


